Immediate aid for evacuees of hazmat incident

Help is on the way for residents and businesses displaced by the hazmat crisis at GKN in Garden Grove.

If you were in the evacuation zone, you are eligible for a \$500 virtual Mastercard distributed by Orange County United Way. Please call 911. You will be required to produce proof (like an electric or phone bill) that you live in the evacuation zone and some type of ID. The aid is limited to one per household and is first come, first served.

I urge you to call as soon as possible because the funding is currently capped at \$3 million. I am working hard to identify other potential areas of aid for my constituents.

The County of Orange Healthcare Agency has also created a webpage where the public can check air quality levels in real time at www.occupainfo.com. That page will also list important information about upcoming events, such as when GKN will remove existing liquid from two tanks that were not related to the hazardous incident.
